## Mary Ann Merkl Genealogy Collection Notebooks 1 through 7 and Box 1 Finding Aid

According to her February 10, 2006 obituary in the Starkville Daily News, Mary Ann Ingram Merkl was born in Montgomery, Alabama on January 13, 1928, and died in Starkville at the age of 78 at Starkville Manor Nursing Home on February 9, 2006. She was married to Dr. Marvin E. Merkl of Starkville, who had a doctoral degree in entomology and did research on the boll weevil in cotton farming (information from his July 16, 2006 obituary). The family attended First United Methodist Church and lived on Cottonwood Drive in Starkville. The Merkls had three sons, Gene and Alan, both of Starkville; and Bruce Merkl of Lafayette, Louisiana. They also had a daughter, Linda Ann Merkl who became ill and died at the age of 41 on June 26, 1996 (from Linda Ann's June 27, 1996 obituary).

Mary Ann was a homemaker and loved to research her family history. Evidently, Linda Ann helped her mother do the research on the family history, because one of her genealogical research notebooks on the Merkl family, is a part of the Mary Ann Merkl Genealogical Papers, and a few of the letters in the collection were addressed to Linda Ann.

Mary Ann Merkl was "a lifetime member of the Junior Auxiliary", and, like her husband, was an avid supporter of MSU tennis. She was a member of the "U. S. Tennis Association and the Mississippi State University Tennis Boosters."

This collection was originally inventoried by Carolyn Reed and processed by Perian Kerr, who created folder names for loose materials in document case and replaced several of the damaged notebooks, created labels for the notebooks and the document case. She also created this finding aid.

## Provenance:

This collection is primarily Mary Ann Ingram Merkl's collection, but her daughter also helped her mother with the family research, because the collection contains one of Linda Ann's Merkl family research notebook, and some of her correspondence papers. The seven main notebooks are Mary Ann Merkl's research. Her husband was still living at the time that this collection was donated (he died later in the same year), so he or one of the sons probably donated this collection to the library. We have no signed deed of gift.

Arrangement: Notebooks contents were kept in the same order as when they were donated. Contents pages were created for the covers on two of the notebooks and for the front page of every notebook, and for the document case. Since the materials that were put into the document case had no arrangement, an arrangement had to be created. Book and notebook first, then files. Correspondence, family group sheets, Family Tree Journal (computer program instructions), Genealogical Notes, then Surname Files: Bryant, Garrett, Ingram, Merkl, Merkl-Hollingsworth, Norwood, Pitts, Ponder, and Toles.
